On behalf of the GSN team I wish you a warm welcome to Munich, the LMU and the GSN.

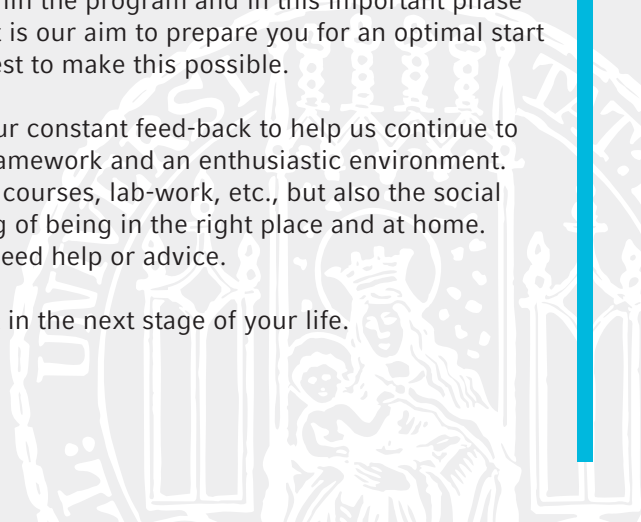

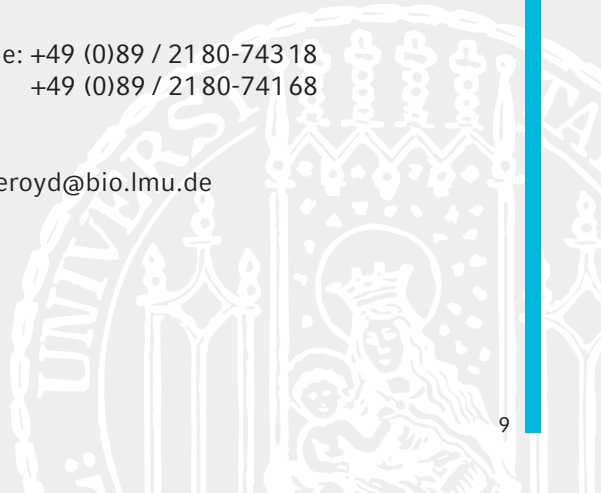

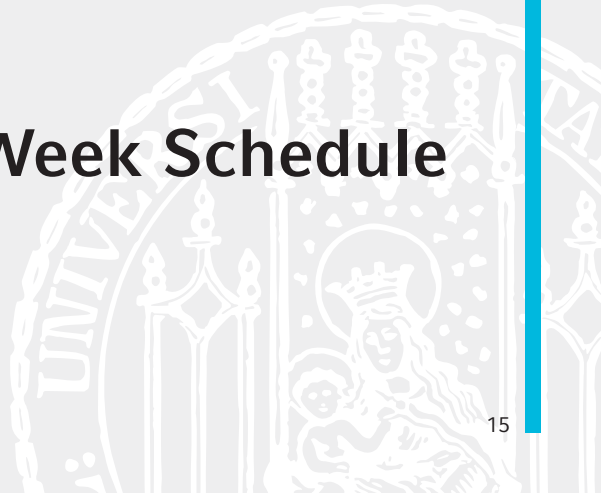
